An overview of what children will be learning in Hawthorn Class
Summer Term 2024

English

In writing lessons, we are creating our own biographies about Howard Carter based on his discoveries in Egypt. We have explored his early career, how he became involved with ancient Egyptian studies and his later life.

Our next writing focus is on *The Last Garden* by Rachel Ip and Anneli Bray. We will create narratives based on this emotive inspiring tale.

Reading lessons will focus on *The White Fox* by Jackie Morris.

PE

We will be working on our athletic skills. We will also review our performances and identify areas of strength and what to improve on.

RE

We will explore Pentecost and how this is celebrated by Christians. We will also explore how and why people mark significant events in their life.

Maths

In maths lessons, we will be focusing on refining our division and multiplication methods. 3 digits by a single digit. After this, we will then move onto length and perimeter activities and fractions.

Times tables are a major focus. Year 3's will be learning their 3's, 4's and 8's, while the year 4's should know all their times tables by the end of the year.

Year 4's will be completing a times table check in June. Regular times table practice on TTRS is recommended for all pupils.

Science

We are exploring space. We will learn about different types of eclipses, what is a solar system, what space is made up of and the jobs of astronauts. We will also learn about what the universe is and how the planets differ.
